**Judging Time: Friday 10:30 A.M. EST**

**Entry Fees to the UPSF- \$6.00 per class Stall Fee; \$10.00 per head**

**All fees must be paid at the time of entry. No refunds will be given on entry fees.**

**Entry Fees to MWHCA: complete entry form at the Midwest Highland Web Site**

**Placement Time: Wednesday, 8:00 A.M. - 8:00 P.M. EST and Thursday 8:00 A.M. - 3:00 P.M. EST. All cattle must be in place by 3:00 P.M. EST on Thursday.**

### **USE ENTRY FORM #004 for UPSF Open Show**

All exhibitors must report to the Superintendent before unloading or stalling their cattle. All U.P. residents are required to be on the grounds by 8:00 P.M., Monday and remain until Sunday.

Release Time: Lower Michigan and out of state exhibitors will be released by 4:00 P.M. EST on Sunday. All U.P. exhibitors will be released on Sunday by UP Zone release times.

#### **U.P. State Fair rules to be followed:**

1. A ribbon placed on any animal is no guarantee of a premium award. We must be governed strictly by the records on the judge's sheets.
2. Double entries allowed in individual classes unless otherwise indicated. Single entries only in group classes. Cow and last calf are considered an individual class.
3. First prize winners are only eligible for Champion prizes. Second prize animals may compete for Reserve Championships.
4. See information regarding Bovine Virus Diarrhea. (BVD) testing requirements. The animal on the test form is to be identified by the RFID or other approved federal tags.

American Highland Cattle Association (AHCA) rules for sanctioned shows.

AHCA policy statement concerning highland breeding cattle for the show ring. It is neither the desire nor the business of AHCA to act as a show ring policeman. It is however, within the scope of AHCA's responsibilities to maintain the integrity of the breed and its breeders. This includes the promotion of the breed in an attractive public setting by both amateur and professional exhibitors, building camaraderie and participation among owners and enthusiasts and encouraging selection of highly productive cattle with attributes of the Highland breed. It is also within the scope of AHCA's responsibilities to mediate and ensure the ongoing contentment within its constituency.

1. Exhibitors must be member in good standing of the American Highland Cattle Association or Canadian Highland Cattle Society.
2. All animals must be owned by the exhibitor and breeding stock registered with the American Highland Cattle Association or the Canadian Highland Cattle Society.
3. All shows will conform with IAFE show rules.
4. Registration papers must be presented to show officials or AHCA representatives upon request.
5. Tattoos must be legible and correspond to registration papers
6. Use of hormones or steroids in animals exhibited is prohibited.
7. Breeding cattle may not be dehorned.
8. A calf in the cow/calf class must be the cow's natural calf, still nursing and a maximum of 250 days old.
9. All bulls 12 months or older must be shown with a nose ring or nose lead. PLEASE NOTE: We recommend that bulls be experienced with nose ring or nose lead prior to showing the

animal.

10. All ROE shows attended will be counted in the cow/calf division. In the case of a tie for cow/calf division, the cow/calf that has defeated the most animals will be the winner.
11. Registered and unregistered steers (both pure and crossbred) and registered Sovereign heifers, will be included for the number of animals in a point show.
12. Only registered pure and crossbred steers and registered Sovereign heifers will count toward the Premier Breeder and Exhibitor awards at all ROE shows.
13. Cattle registered in group classes must be registered purebred Highland cattle.
14. Jackpot classes will be left to the discretion of each individual show.
15. All cattle names and registration numbers will be verified on herd book search on ACHA website.
16. All owners will be verified as current members of ACHA and cattle entered are in their ownership.
